#### **Elementary Art Lesson Plan**

# **Snail**

**Objective:** Students will focus on craftsmanship of coloring and line quality by drawing spirals.

Recommended for kindergarten – 4th grade

#### **Materials:**

Provided by Art to Remember:

Paper

Additional supplies:

- Pencil
- Tempera paint
- Paint brush
- Pencil with eraser (to swirl the paint)
- Black Sharpie
- Crayons

### **Open the Conversation:**

Students will discuss how different the world would look from a snail's perspective. What details would they see around them if they were as small as a snail?

#### **Step One:**

Place a small amount of paint in the center of the page. Students will use a paint brush to swirl it into a circle, creating the shell.

#### **Step Two:**

Use the eraser end of a pencil to create a swirl in the paint when it is still wet. Allow the paint to dry completely before moving onto step three.
