





Overview

Ladybugs are created by printing red dots and adding a few shapes and lines.

Supplies

- Red tempera/acrylic paint
- Round sponge brush
- Black marker









Paper option

The background page can be created in many ways. In this example, a paint stick is used to draw onto a cookie sheet. Then sprayed with water (in this case dyed yellow). The paper is then pressed onto the cookie sheet and the paints and water are transferred onto the paper. To see more options, click here.



Step 1Pour a small amount of red paint into a tray.

Step 2

Use a round sponge, dip into the paint and press onto the paper several times. Allow dry time after this step.







Step 3

Draw small curves on the red dots with a black marker. Fill in the curve. From the center of the curve, draw a line across the red dot. Then place equal dots on either side of the line.









Step 4

Repeat this process with all of the red dots.
